

**I'll Do It..**

You may have heard this one before: "There were four people named Everybody, Somebody, Anybody, and Nobody. An important job

had to be done: Everybody was asked to do it. Everybody was sure Somebody would do it. Anybody could have done it, but Nobody did it. Somebody got angry, because it was Everybody's job. Everybody thought Anybody could do it but Nobody realized that Everybody wouldn't do it. So Everybody blamed Somebody when Nobody did what Anybody could have done." Isaiah in a vision sees God's overpowering holiness and majesty and realizes the gulf between him and God and between God and God's people. An angel declares, "Your wickedness is removed, your sin is purged." God asks, "Who will go for us?" and Isaiah immediately replies, "Here I am; send me!" (Isaiah 6:7, 8, 9). Isaiah doesn't look for someone else, he makes no excuses, he does not hesitate. Nor does he ask what God requires; he has unbounded trust and willingness to do God's will. Simon Peter and his friends in today's Gospel have caught nothing. Jesus tells them to cast their nets in deep water, and the catch is huge. Like Isaiah, Simon Peter is only conscious of his own sinfulness, but Jesus tells him not to be afraid. Simon and his crew simply trust, and leave everything to follow Jesus.

Ash Wednesday is February 17

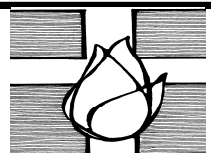
We will have mass and the distribution of ashes at 7:00 in the evening. The Workers Ashes will be available inside the church during the day for those who will be unable to attend Mass.

En las lecturas de hoy oyemos tres ocasiones en que algunas personas reciben y responden a un llamado de Dios. Estos relatos siguen el patrón de la mayoría de los relatos de llamados: una presencia di-

vina aparece y habla; la persona expresa temor o no ser digna, recibe aliento, y finalmente responde al llamado de Dios. La primera lectura de hoy nos muestra a un indigno Isaías respondiendo al llamado de Dios: "Aquí estoy, Señor, envíame" (Isaías 6:8). En la segunda lectura Pablo nos dice que, aunque había perseguido a la Iglesia, fue llamado a ser apóstol. En el Evangelio, a pesar de la protesta de Simón Pedro de que es pecador, Jesús llama a Santiago, a Juan y a Simón para que lo sigan. Dejan todo lo que poseen y siguen a Jesús— se convierten en discípulos de Jesús. Estas lecturas bíblicas desafían a evaluar nuestras vidas. ¿Cómo sentimos en nuestras vidas el llamado de Jesús a ser discípulos? ¿Estamos respondiendo bien y con fidelidad?
